7. Military Grant can only be used for undergraduate and master's degrees (excludes ThM and doctoral degrees). _____
8. Students must submit an application every semester and every term. Sub-terms, such as Fall 1 and Fall 2 may be combined into one application. _____
9. The "Financial Aid" registration hold on a student's account is due to this grant. Students may change schedules by either adding or dropping a course. However, students will need to contact the Financial Aid Office to have holds removed.

 If students plan to add a course, a new application must be submitted with updated class hours and a new signature from the Commanding Officer. _____
