All employees, volunteers, faculty and staff are required (yearly) to submit to this inquiry before operating any vehicle while on official duty for SBTS.

PLEASE READ AND SIGN THE FOLLOWING

I authorize The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary to conduct, or hire services to conduct, an MVR regarding my driver's license history. I authorize any parties contacted to release information to my employer or its agent (e.g., a consumer reporting agency) regarding my driving record, licenses, certifications, or other information contained in the MVR. I release all persons and entities from liability for damages that may arise from the release of this information. I waive all provisions of law prohibiting the disclosure of information.

I understand that The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary and its agents cannot guarantee the accuracy of any information reported to it by third parties.

An unsatisfactory MVR would include: more than one accident/moving violation within the past 12 months, more than two accidents/moving violations within the past 36 months, DUI conviction, speeding violation greater than 20 mph over the speed limit, hit and run conviction, wreckless driving conviction, or more than 6 points against license for all offenses.

Failure to maintain a satisfactory MVR may result in revocation of authorization to drive a seminary vehicle.

Any traffic violations or accident that could affect your MVR must immediately be reported to your supervisor.

FOR PROPER INSURANCE CLAIMS REPORTING

If you are involved in a vehicle accident on seminary property, notify Campus Police immediately at (502) 897-4444 to file a report.

If the vehicle accident occurs off seminary property, immediately notify the local police department having jurisdiction to file a report. After the report has been filed with the local police, call Campus Police at (502) 897-4444 to notify them of the accident and relay the report number to them.
