Campus Police has responsibility for security, risk management and fire safety functions. The Chief of Campus Police reports to the Senior VP of Institutional Administration who reports directly to the President.

The Campus Police Department consists of about 20 personnel including dispatchers and 13 Special Local Peace Officers with authority delineated in KRS 61.360.

Police officers and dispatchers are on duty 24/7 and all officers are certified in first aid and CPR. We monitor the campus by CCTV and officers patrol the campus by car, ATV, bicycle, and foot.

The Campus Police Department works collaboratively with other campus authority personnel to provide the safest possible environment for all campus members.

We maintain an excellent working relationship with local authorities. This includes the Louisville Metro Police Department, Louisville Fire Department, State Fire Marshal and other government agencies.

Description of Information Programs

Southern Seminary and Boyce College have developed policies and procedures, offer educational programs and cooperate with local law enforcement agencies to enhance the safety and security of students, employees, and guests. Southern Seminary and Boyce College recognize shared responsibility for the welfare of the community. Campus Police also offer numerous safety programs on campus. These include fire prevention, CPR/1st Aid/AED training, new student orientation, crime prevention, fire drills and student leader training. Training is also provided as it relates to emergency messaging and notifications in the event of major crimes or other incidents.

We use the RAVE Alert emergency notification system for emergency and other notifications affecting the campus.

Crime Prevention information is made available at the beginning of each semester during student orientation. Our website is also a good source of information related to crime prevention and other security related matters.

Statements of Policies and Procedures

It is the policy of Southern Seminary and Boyce College to issue a timely notice to the campus community of any crime reported to Campus Police or to the local police department, and which we are made aware of, that presents a safety or security threat.

Blue Light Emergency Phone

There is a Blue Light emergency phone is located near Lot #13, between Carver Hall and the Library. The phone is connected to the Campus Police Department which operates 24/7.

For Security Considerations in Facilities Maintenance

Facilities management services (Sodexo) regularly monitors all campus facilities for necessary safety and security-related repairs and partners closely with the Campus Police Department to assist in creating a safer campus community. To request service for an electrical, plumbing, or other maintenance-related problems, call the Housing line at (502)897-4203.

Safety tips when using Lyft:

- 1) TRAVEL IN PAIRS: Travel with a friend – the “safety in numbers” concept really works, especially if your judgment is impaired.
- 2) VERIFY YOUR DRIVER AND CAR: Once you have requested a Lyft ride, you can view the driver’s rating. When your ride arrives, make sure the driver’s photo, license plate number, and vehicle description match. Never take a ride you did not request or get into a car that doesn’t match the details provided by the Lyft app.
- 3) GO THE EXTRA MILE: The Lyft app’s “share your ETA” function allows you to invite friends to see your trip in real-time. The app will draft a text message you can share with friends that includes your ETA and a link to a live map that allows them to track your trip. Too much effort? Call a friend and stay on the line while you’re in the car instead.
