***Foundational seminars** are taken in accord with program concentration. Consult the Professional Doctoral Studies Handbook for a list of these courses.

****Contextualized Writing Seminars** allow students to progress in writing the Ministry Research Project from the first semester alongside the foundational seminar courses.

*****Project Methodology** is required for all students. Taken during the second semester, it focuses on developing the Ministry Research Project proposal.

******Doctor of Educational Ministry students** are required to complete **two educational seminars**. These are typically taken during the last year of study, but may be completed earlier if desired. These are offered entirely online.

*******Students who are in the writing stage of the program and have completed all seminars** must enroll in the **Ministry Research Project and Writing** each semester in year three until they graduate.

*******The Cooperative Program** course is a one-time, non-curricular requirement for doctoral students. All course work is completed online through Canvas and may be done at any point during the semester.
