<p>Essentials I deals with your calling as a Christian; your calling as a wife; your influence on children; time management; listening skills; and practical budgeting matters. You will gain insights that will shape your walk as a ministry wife for years to come.</p>

<p>The Bible mentions 187 women by name and refers to hundreds of nameless women. We can learn priceless lessons from them to see what God wants to teach us on how to be a godly woman; on the other hand, we can also learn from others in God's Word some mistakes to avoid. In this course we will take a look at Esther, Ruth, Jochebed (Moses' mother), the Hebrew midwives, Naaman's wife's maid, the Proverbs 31 woman, Rahab, Lydia, Mary and Martha, Mary, the mother of Jesus, Lois, Eunice and others. We will also learn how to do a biographical Bible study. Students will be expected to write a personal application from the life of each woman we study to turn in weekly, and will choose a woman about whom to write a biographical study to turn in at the end of the course.</p>
